

Korean Language (Beginner2)

Target Learners

This course is designed for learners who wish to study basic Korean (Level 1-B) and meet the following criteria:

- Students who know the consonants and vowels of Hangul and can read Korean
- Students who have some experience with basic Korean expressions (greetings, self-introduction, telling time, directions, etc.)
- Students who have learned initial beginner-level expressions but want to study Korean grammar from the very basics
- Students with approximately 50 hours of Korean learning experience

Educational objectives and learning effects

Educational objectives	This course aims to develop learners' basic Korean communication skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Upon completion, learners will be able to understand and use essential expressions required for daily life, and will gain the ability to read and write simple sentences.
Learning effect	By the end of this course, learners will be able to: -Use and comprehend frequently used beginner-level expressions in daily life through speaking and listening. -Read and write simple sentences and understand and convey basic information in everyday contexts. -Apply basic Korean grammar and expressions to clearly express their own thoughts and feelings.
